Program Overview

Boot Camp is designed for first-year fellows from cardiac anesthesiology, cardiac surgery, cardiology, and vascular surgery. This program emphasizes cross-disciplinary education and training that follows the guiding principles of "Teach broadly. Teach early. Teach basics." The training will provide attendees with two and a half days of intensive expert-led lectures and hands-on training where they will have the opportunity to learn and practice common techniques, gain exposure to various devices, and conduct cadaveric and explant model dissections illustrating anatomy and exposure techniques.

Needs Assessment

This course provides fellows in cardiac anesthesiology, cardiac surgery, cardiology and vascular surgery with an innovative and collaborative educational opportunity to master the basic knowledge and skills for cardiovascular topics. Boot Camp provides the opportunity for personalized instruction. A low ratio of students to faculty provides attendees the benefit of one-on-one teaching and training. Training in the skills of cardiovascular surgery techniques is important to better serve patients, improve outcomes and maintain a competitive advantage. The goal of this course is to provide up-to-date evidence based didactic lectures along with expert-instructed hands-on skills lab training.
