Program Overview

This educational program provides didactic and practical training relating to the following aspects of mechanical ventilation: Closed loop control of ventilation with Adaptive Support Ventilation, Esophogeal/Transpulmonary/VCO2 Monitoring, optimal PEEP and lung recruitment, monitoring of pulmonary mechanics and dysschrony.

Needs Assessment

The Houston Methodist Respiratory Care Services host the Clinical Expert Workshops to train participants in commonly used and validated specific Respiratory Care procedures for mechanically ventilated patients including pressure volume loops, recruitment maneuvers, and esophageal pressure measurements to properly demonstrate a patient's response to the procedures. This is a crucial and life saving measure that is important to the hospital's patient survival rate. Due to the importance of performing this life saving procedure, this program provides a realistic and controlled environment to create confidence in the hospital's fellows and respiratory therapists.

- Successfully complete Esophogeal/transpulmonary/VCO2 monitoring
